BC64, E61, E62, E66, E67, T64, T68, BS61 (Richmond), E70, SQ70, E69, E13, INV20 (CCCFPD), BC71, E171 (El Cerrito), E175 (Rodeo-Hercules), and BC7 (Pinole) responded to a report of a commercial structure fire at the address listed above. E62 arrived first on scene, confirmed a working fire in a medium-size warehouse, and established "Chesley IC". Crews made an aggressive fire attack to limit the fire to the building of origin and prevent it from spreading to the adjacent wood pallet storage yard. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters. The above incident illustrates the successful collaboration among Battalion 7 and West County fire crews, representing five different agencies, working together to protect the lives and property of the citizens we serve.
