Contra Costa Fire units responded to a reported structure fire this evening in Walnut Creek. Engine 2 (Pleasant Hill) reported seeing a large column of grey smoke while enroute to the fire. Upon arrival, Engine 2 found a well-involved garage and attic fire in a one story single family house with a power line down in the street. All fire units were committed to fire attack, search, water supply, overhaul and salvage. The main body of fire was extinguished within 30 minutes. The residence had a metal roof that had been placed on top of the old wood shake roof. The shake roof continued to smolder and the entire metal roof had to be removed from the house to ensure that all of the smoldering shake tiles had been extinguished. This roof operation took crews over 2 hours to complete. The fire was extinguished due to the hard work of the on scene crews.

One adult female was displaced by the fire and will be staying with family. No injuries were reported.
