Contra Costa Fire units responded to a reported structure fire in Antioch. Engine 81 (Antioch) reported seeing a column of smoke and flames while enroute to the incident. Upon arrival Captain 81 found 2 homes that were involved in fire. Due to the large amount of fire showing and the probability of fire spreading beyond the 2 initial homes, a 2nd alarm was requested. All fire units committed to fire attack, searches for victims, water supply, back up hose lines, safety, overhaul and salvage. The fire was held to the 2 buildings of origin because of an aggressive fire attack and well-coordinated team work with on scene crews. Both homes sustained heavy damage. A family of 5 was displaced from one home and the other home was unoccupied. No injuries to residents or firefighters were reported.

The cause of the fire is currently under investigation.
