ASSISTING AGENCIES: ECCFPD, Con EMS, Antioch PD, PGE, Animal Control

Contra Costa Fire units responded to a reported structure fire this afternoon in Antioch. Engine 82 (Antioch) reported smoke from the front window of a two story house. Captain 82 confirmed a fire on the first floor and initiated a working structure fire response. All fire units were committed to fire attack, searches for victims, water supply, back up hose lines, safety, overhaul and salvage. The fire was quickly extinguished because of an aggressive fire attack and well-coordinated team work with on scene crews.

At the time of the fire no one was home, however a neighbor reported that an elderly male was potentially still inside. Crews quickly performed an aggressive primary search and determined that the house was unoccupied. During their search, crews were able to rescue two cats and one dog.

The fire is believed to be started from a heating lamp on a turtle tank.
