All concerned,

BC 1, E3, E2, E5, Inv. 20, BC 2, E15, E17, STC 10, M18, BS 7, T1, responded to the report of a residential structure fire. Upon arrival, Capt. 1 had heavy smoke and fire from 2 windows and a carport area of a single story residential structure. There was also heavy fire to the rear of the structure. BC 1 established I.C. and assigned crews to perform an aggressive exterior fire attack from the front to ensure the fire did not spread to the adjacent house. Fire crews placed a line to the rear of the house as well to assist with extinguishing the fire on the backside of the house. The fire was well involved in the structure and crews were unable to go inside the structure for fire attack. All crews worked extremely hard to mitigate this incident which included extensive overhaul. There were no injuries to firefighters however, one of the residents was transported for minor injuries and 2 cats were found deceased in the bedroom.
