LOCATION: 184 Heather Dr. San Pablo

RESPONSE: 5 Engines, 1 Truck, 1 Breathing Support Unit, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator, 1 Squad, 2 Medic Units, 1 Training Captain Assisting Agencies: Con EMS, San Pablo/Richmond PD, PG&E, Red Cross, Richmond Fire, Pinole Fire, Rodeo Hercules Fire Total Fire Personnel at Scene: 30

A structure fire was reported at this location. Upon arrival of the first unit, they encountered heavy smoke and flames from the rear and inside of a single story residential structure with exposures threatened. It was immediately declared a working fire and crews began an aggressive offensive fire attack. Command was passed from the first in captain to the next arriving unit as it may have been a rescue involved. A unit was directed from the street to the rear of house to stop any threat to other exposures. After fire was knocked down, it was confirmed that all occupants were safe and not in the residence. All crews worked hard to extinguish fire, check for extension and perform a primary and secondary search. The fire was contained to that property with minor damage to adjoining fences. The house suffered extensive damage from fire and smoke and deemed uninhabitable. One occupant suffered minor burns or scraps to his fingers but, declined treatment. No firefighters reported any injuries. Cause of the fire is under investigation. Any questions, please call.
