All concerned,

I wanted to clarify some information that was shared on the narrative of the Significant Incident report on Friday September 28th at 2009 Heaton Circle. The report stated that the "homeowner" was taken into custody. That information was incorrect and I apologize for the confusion. The tenant that was renting the property was taken into custody by Concord P.D

Contra Costa County Fire units responded to a report of a garage fire with an explosion today at 15:29. Upon arrival the crews found light smoke coming from a 2 car garage of a single story house. Within minutes the fire engulfed the entire garage and began to spread to the residence. Crews performed a well-coordinated, aggressive fire attack along with rooftop ventilation, as well as a primary search of the structure. The fire was quickly extinguished with minimal damage to the interior of the structure. Upon further investigation by Concord P.D the garage was determined to be a drug manufacture lab. No injuries were reported and the tenant on scene was taken into custody by Concord P.D.
