Contra Costa County Fire Engine 86 (Bay Point), Engine 87(Pittsburg), Engine 85 (Pittsburg), Truck 84 (Pittsburg), Engine 82 (Antioch), Engine 81 (Antioch) Investigator 20 (Pittsburg), Safety Officer 10 (Concord) 1122(El Sobrante) & EMS 8 responded to a reported Residential Structure Fire. Upon arrival Captain 86 reported smoke from the rear of a small strip mall and established command and initiated a working fire. All Companies worked to extinguish the fire and perform salvage and overhaul. No firefighters or civilians were hurt. The fire building was a small residence behind the commercial structure. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and at this time the cause was determined to be an unattended candle in the corner of the living room.
