Upon arrival Captain 87 reported smoke from all eaves of a single story residence. All Companies worked tirelessly to extinguish this stubborn seated fire. One male resident was taken to the Hospital as a precaution. All companies performed extinguishment and salvage and overhaul. No firefighters were hurt. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and at this time the cause is still under investigation.
