ASSISTING AGENCIES: Antioch PD, PG&E, AMR, Red Cross

TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 44

All Concerned -

Contra Costa County Fire- Engines 81, 85, 11, 87, 88, 82, Rescue 10, Trucks 84, 83 & 6, Breathing Support 7, Training Captain 10, Investigator 20, Medic units 58 and 52 & EMS 8 responded to a reported Commercial structure fire in a 2 story apartment complex. Upon arrival E81 reported heavy fire from a two story apartment complex. Upon investigation a stove top fire that spread to the cabinets and wall coverings was reported. The stovetop was found to be on fire and quickly extinguished. Crews on scene were able to confine the fire to the Building of origin. Extensive salvage and overhaul were performed. All 28 residents of the apartment were assisted with alternative living arrangements through Red Cross. All Fire and EMS units supported evacuation and fire suppression roles effectively. All units were committed for the length of the incident. No injuries to Firefighters or civilians were reported.
