Type of Alarm: Residential Structure Fire

Location: 2206 Greenbrier St., Concord

Response: 6-Engines, 1-Truck, 1-Breathing Support, 2-Battalion Chiefs, 1-Training Captain

Assisting Agencies: CON EMS, Concord PD, PG&E, Red Cross

Total Fire Personnel at Scene: 27

Contra Costa Fire units responded to a residential structure fire in Concord. Engine 6 (Concord) reported seeing a column of smoke while enroute to the fire. Dispatch upgraded the response to a working structure fire and added additional units. Upon arrival, Engine 6 found heavy smoke and fire from the front (alpha) and left (bravo) side of a one story house and two residents sitting on the curb. The fire extended from the kitchen into the living room and attic. All units were committed to fire attack, search, water supply, overhaul, and salvage. The fire was quickly extinguished thanks to an aggressive fire attack. After initial fire knockdown, the training captain was able to remove a fish tank with fish and a gecko for the resident's daughter.

Red Cross was contacted for 4 adults and one minor resident of the house. Two residents sustained minor injuries exiting the house and were treated on scene by CON EMS.
