Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 81 (Antioch), Engine 82(Antioch), Engine 85(Pittsburg), Engine 86(BayPoint), Engine 87(Pittsburg), Truck 6 (Concord), Truck 84(Pittsburg), Truck 83 (Antioch) Training Captain/Safety Officer10 (Concord), Breathing Support 7 (Walnut Creek), Investigator 20 (Pittsburg) and 1 Paramedic Unit & 1 Paramedic Supervisor responded to a reported Commercial structure fire in an Apartment Complex at the address above. Upon arrival Engine 85 reported light smoke coming from a 2 story Apartment Complex and established Leland IC. E81 was assigned primary fire attack, Truck 83 and Truck 84 were assigned search and ventilation. Additional units supported these operations commensurate with the strategic objectives. All units were committed for the length of the incident. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and the determination was made undetermined was decided upon. Significant water and smoke damage resulted and the fire was contained to the apartment of origin. During this incident, Engine There were no injuries to Firefighters or civilians.
