The fire was quickly knocked down and all crews were directed to salvage and overhaul. The origin of the fire was the kitchen stove area. A fire cause investigation is ongoing. All residents were found to be out of the building and none were hurt. Damage was significant and the resident was offered and accepted Red Cross services.
