



## SIGNIFICANT INCIDENT NOTIFICATION

WHEN: July 10, 2018

WHERE: 2601 Carlton Ln Antioch

TIME: 1:34 pm

Contra Costa County Fire Protection District units were dispatched to a reported structure fire. Heavy smoke was reported seen enroute. Upon arrival, the first unit was met with heavy smoke and fire from what appeared to be at least 2 units of a 10 unit apartment complex. The first in officer immediately called it a working structure fire and requested a second alarm. Crews were given assignments effecting a aggressive offensive fire attack. With the amount of fire and potential for loosing the entire complex, the crews made a very good stop of the fire and mainly the first 3 units suffered the most damage. Crews aggressively fought fire, cut holes in the roof to release smoke and heat, performed a primary and secondary search of occupants to insure they were out of the structure. One young adult and two small children were checked and transported my ConFirre Medics for possible smoke inhalation and released later in the day. I need to mention, the temperature was in the low 90's, most of the crews just left the earlier incident yet, they performed admirably with no reported injuries. Any questions, please call.
