All concerned,

BC 1, E5 (Pleasant Hill), BC 2, E6, T6, and TC 10 (Concord), BS 7, E1, T1, E3 (Walnut Creek), E15, and E17 (Lafayette), responded to the report of a residential structure fire. Upon arrival, Capt. 3 had a back deck on fire which extended into the residence. There were initial reports of someone possibly trapped in the residence. Capt. 3 passed command to Capt. 15 which allowed E3 and E1 to go into rescue mode. A second alarm was requested for the incident. After an aggressive offensive fire attack combined with a thorough primary search, no victims were found inside the residence. The two occupants of the residence were found safely outside. The second alarm was canceled, and the fire

was contained to just one unit. This fire was possibly started by a cigarette that was left unattended on the back deck. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me.
