Contra Costa County Fire Engine 88 (Antioch), Engine 87(Pittsburg), Engine 85 (Pittsburg), Truck 83 (Antioch), Engine 82 (Antioch), Engine 81 (Antioch) Investigator 20 (Pittsburg), Safety Officer 10 (Concord) Battalion 8(Pittsburg) Battalion 2(Concord), EMS 8 and 4 Paramedic Ambulances responded to what was reported as a Vehicle accident that caused a vehicle fire that extended into vegetation and into an adjoining residence. Upon the arrival of E88, Captain 88 reported heavy fire exposing the Alpha & Bravo corners of a 2 story house. He established incident command and transmitted a working fire. The initial Vehicle accident sent 5 people from the vehicle to local hospitals. The home sustained major damage but no residents were hurt. The 4 residents of the home were not able to return to the hospital and Red Cross assisted relocation and additional services. All Fire companies worked to extinguish the fire and perform salvage and overhaul. No firefighters or civilians were hurt. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and at this time the cause was determined to be the vehicle accident. .
