Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 70 & Squad 70(San Pablo), Engine 61, Engine 62, T64, E67 (Richmond Fire), Investigator 20(Pittsburg), Battalion 71 (EL Cerrito), Battalion 64(Richmond) and Battalion 7(El Sobrante) responded to a Working Residential Structure fire. E62 arrived to find a garage on fire. The an aggressive fire attack posture was taken and the damage was kept to just the garage. All units performed salvage and overhaul. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and the incident was ruled unintentional. The origin of the fire was an area in the garage near a refridgerator. All residents were found to be out of the building and none were hurt. Damage was significant and the residents was offered and accepted Red Cross services. No injuries occurred to any firefighters or civilians and the incident was terminated and the home was turned over to the owner and the board up Co.
