RESPONSE: 8 Engines, 1 Truck Company, 1 Breathing Support Unit, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator

ASSISTING AGENCIES: Con EMS, Walnut creek PD, PG & E

TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 30

CCCFPD firefighters were dispatched to a residential garage fire. Fire units reported smoke and flames visible from the area even prior to arriving on scene. Upon arrival, Captain 10 reported smoke and flames from three sides of the single story home. The home was well involved and firefighter had to knock down the flames from the outside prior to entering the interior of the home. All occupants had left the home safely. The fire was under control in approximately 20 minutes. There was extensive damage to the home. The fire started in the garage and CCCFPD Arson Investigators arrived to determine cause. Damage to the home is estimated at \$400,000. The unintentional fire cause was still undetermined and under investigation.
