### **Battalion 2** *Incident Notification*

**DATE:** 12/14/18

**TIME:** 13:25

**TYPE OF ALARM:** Working Residential Structure Fire

**LOCATION:** 3931 Juniper Dr. Concord

**RESPONSE:** E6-T6-E8-E22-E10-BC2-BC1-1124-EMS 1-PD-PGE-

At 1:25pm, Contra Costa County Fire Units were dispatched to smoke coming from the roof vents of a single family residence. Upon arrival, Truck 6 reported smoke showing from the attic vents of the structure. Battalion 2 and Engine 6 arrived within seconds after Truck 6. Engine 6 immediately began an offensive fire attack, while Truck 6 went to the roof to preform vertical ventilation for fire crews below. The interior crews were able to get a quick knock down of the fire and a primary search of the structure, which resulted in no occupants found. As additional units arrived, they were assigned to various fire ground duties. Due to the early notification from alert neighbors, and aggressive offensive fire attack by Con Fire crews we were able to hold the fire to the kitchen and attic space directly above the fire.

Red Cross was requested to provide shelter for three adults and two children, which they did.

After further investigation it was determined that a faulty electrical box more than likely caused the fire. The estimation of damage will likely be close to \$150,000+.

No injuries to the residents or fire department personnel was reported at the conclusion of the incident.
