All concerned,

BC 1, E2, E5, (Pleasant Hill), BC 2, E6, STC 10, Inv. 20, M15, M19 (Concord), BS 7 (Walnut Creek), E9 (Pacheco), and E13, T14 (Martinez) responded to the report of a residential structure fire. Upon arrival, Capt. 9 had heavy smoke and flames from the 2nd story and back side of a two story residence. This was a house that was under construction. All fire units initially assisted in fire attack from a defensive operation due to all the open truss construction and amount of fire involvement. Unknown how the fire initially started and is under investigation. The homeowner, a middle aged male, sustained minor burns to the right side of his body. He was transported by M15 to John Muir Hospital-

--Walnut Creek. Once the fire was knocked down from the exterior, all fire units transitioned to an offensive operation and performed overhaul. Red Cross was called in to assist and house two adults. There were no injuries to firefighters. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me.
