#### *Incident Notification*

**DATE:** January 27, 2019

**TIME OF ALARM:** 2029 hrs.

**TYPE OF ALARM:** Structure Fire

**LOCATION:** 415 Saddlebrook Ln. Pleasant Hill

**RESPONSE:** 4 Type 1 Engines, 2 Truck Companies, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator, 1 Shift Training Captain

**ASSISTING AGENCIES:** PG & E, Pleasant Hill PD

**TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE:** 22

A single alarm working fire was reported at 415 Saddlebrook Ln in Pleasant Hill. Upon arrival, Engine 13 (Martinez) reported black smoke from the garage of a two story house. A well coordinated fire attack by Engine 2 and Engine 13, enabled crews to declare knock down on the fire within 10 minutes. All units assigned to the fire were committed to checking for extension in the house, searching for victims, providing water supply, ventilating the house and overhauling the structure to ensure that the fire was completely extinguished.

Two adults managed to flee the structure without injuries. In addition, the fire was kept to the garage with minimal damage to the interior of the house.

The fire is believed to be started from smoking materials on the exterior.
