TYPE OF ALARM: Structure Fire

LOCATION: 4208 Valley Ave. in Martinez

RESPONSE: 5 Type 1 Engines, 1 Truck Company, 1 Breathing Support Unit, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator, 1 Shift Training Captain

ASSISTING AGENCIES: Con EMS., PG & E, Red Cross

TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 25

A single alarm working fire was reported at 4208 Valley Ave. in Martinez. Upon arrival, Engine 9 (Pacheco) reported heavy black smoke from the front of the house. The fire was determined to be in the garage on the sub level of the residence. Engine 9 made a quick attack on the fire while additional crews began to arrive. All units assigned to the fire were committed checking for extension into the main body of the house, searching for victims, providing water supply, ventilating the house and overhauling the structure to ensure that the fire was completely extinguished.

At the time of this writing, no injuries had been reported to either firefighters or civilians. The fire displaced two adults and a dog. Red Cross was called for and came to the scene to assist the family.

The cause of the fire is undetermined at the time of this writing.
