**RESPONSE: 6 Engines, 3 Trucks, 3 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Shift Training Captain, 1 Breathing Support, 1 Fire Investigator**

**Assisting Agencies: Con Fire EMS, County Sheriffs, PG&E, Red Cross, Emergency Construction Services**

**Contra Costa Fire responded to a reported residential structure fire early yesterday evening in Bay Point. Engine 86 (Bay Point) reported a column of smoke while enroute. Upon arrival Engine 86 reported heavy black smoke from the rear of the house that had spread inside the house and attic space. A second alarm was requested because the fire had spread into two neighboring backyards and caught 3 sheds on fire. Firefighters extinguished the 3 sheds on fire to save 2 homes from burning. At the same time a coordinated plan was placed into action on the house fire. Crews quickly placed hoselines on the burning structure at the same time as cutting holes in the roof for ventilation. This fire was extinguished because of a well coordinated attack by all firefighters on scene. Searches for civilians were all clear. However, 2 cats did succumb to smoke inhalation.**

**3 adults were displaced and being taking care of by Red Cross. A \$100 SAVE card was given to the residents to help them in their time of need. No injuries were reported.**
