ASSISTING AGENCIES: East Contra Costa Fire E353, WT53, Cal Fire TC1606, E1666, E1676, 4 Air Tankers, 2 Helicopters, CCCSO Starr 3, PG&E TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 81 All Concerned, Contra Costa County Firefighters responded to an early afternoon Vegetation Fire on 4379 Glen Canyon Circle in Pittsburg. E85 arrived on scene and reported about 5 acres of grass burning and threatening homes. E85 quickly called for a 2 alarm. Fire crews quickly placed hose lines into place and began extinguishing the fire to protect the homes that were threatened. Air support from Cal Fire and Starr 3 provided water drops to help contain and extinguish this fire. The quick actions from all firefighting resources at the scene saved the threatened homes. The fire spread across the grass in steep terrain which made for a difficult firefight. All fire crews worked to contain this fire at 23 Acres. This was the second vegetation fire of the day. No firefighter were injured. PG&E surveyed the power lines.

The first vegetation fire occurred in Bay Point at the intersection of N. Broadway and Suisun Ave at 10:05 A.M. E86, E87, E85, E383, E308 and Starr 3 stretched over 2000 feet of hose lines over 2 sets of Railroad Tracks and began extinguishing the fire. Starr 3 made water drops to contain this fire at 2 acres. This was an arson fire.
