Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 88 (Antioch), Engine 82(Antioch), Engine 85(Pittsburg), Engine 86(Bay Point), Engine 87(Pittsburg), Engine 53( Oakley), Engine 6 (Concord), Breathing Support 7 ( Walnut Creek), Truck 6 (Concord), Truck 84(Pittsburg), Truck 83 (Antioch), Training Captain/Safety Officer 10 (Concord), Fire Marshal (HQ) 2 Fire Investigators (Concord) and 1 Paramedic Unit & 1 Paramedic Supervisor responded to a reported residential structure fire with the fence and trees behind the address on fire. En Route Battalion 8 reported a column of smoke from Hillcrest and Lone Tree. Upon arrival Battalion 8 reported on scene of a 2 story residential structure with smoke and flames from the rear and that residents were using a garden hose to extinguish, the hydrant was at Fawn Hill wy and Fawn Hill Pl. Battalion 8 established Fawn Glenn IC. CCCSO STARR was on scene within minutes and reported a spot vegetation fire near hillcrest. Fawn Glenn IC requested and additional alarm Vegetation Fire to respond to that area. Battalion 2 was assigned to that area and all additional alarm resources responded to that area. The exterior fire did burn some of the exterior building materials of the houses at 4437 and 4433 Fawn Hill. Structural damage was minimal but the rear of both yards was destroyed. All units supported these operations commensurate with the strategic objectives. All units were committed for the length of the incident. A fire cause and origin investigation was conducted and the determination was made that the fire was unintentional/accidental. There were no injuries to Firefighters or civilians.
