Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 86 (Bay Point), HazMat 21 (Pittsburg), Engine 81(Antioch), Engine 6 (Concord), Engine 9(Pacheco), Truck 84 (Pittsburg), Battalion 8 (Pittsburg), Battalion 2 (Concord), Medic Supervisor 8 (Concord), Medic 5, Training/Safety Captain 10 (Concord), Breathing Support 7 (Walnut Creek), responded to a Working Residential Structure fire. E86 reported smoke en route to the call. Upon arrival a working fire was declared. The fire was quickly knocked down. The origin of the fire was an exterior laundry room. A fire cause investigation is ongoing. All residents were found to be out of the building and none were hurt. Damage was significant and the residents were offered Red Cross services and accepted. No injuries occurred to any firefighters and the incident was terminated and the home was turned over to the Renters. The homeowner was notified.
