Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 81(Antioch), Engine 88 (Antioch), Engine 82(Antioch), Engine 87 (Pittsburg), Engine 86 (Bay Point), Engine 6 (Concord), Battalion 8 (Pittsburg), Battalion 5 (Brentwood), Medic Supervisor 8 (Concord), Medic 54 & Medic 57, Training/Safety Captain 10 (Concord), Breathing Support 7 (Walnut Creek), responded to a Working Residential Structure fire. Based on reporting party information the incident was immediately upgraded to working fire. Upon Arrival Captain 81 reported they were on scene with heavy smoke in the rear of an detached garage and called a working fire. There were reports of children still inside but that was found to be untrue. Captain 81 established Incident Command and offensive fire attack was assigned. A female and male resident were able to escape and both were treated for injuries sustained during the incident. Both were transported to a local hospital for additional treatment and were released. No injuries occurred to any firefighters and the incident was terminated and the home was turned over to the owner. Please call me with any questions related to this incident.
