Total Fire Personnel at scene: 37

Units responded to the report of a structure fire with flames coming from the windows per the reporting party. E10 arrived on scene and reported heavy smoke and fire coming from the front and rear windows on the first floor as well as the attic on the second floor. The first arriving crew was assigned to patient care of the first victim that was found on the front lawn and transported to the hospital. B/C 1 arrived on scene called for an additional alarm and assigned crews to an aggressive fire attack and search for the reported second victim in the structure on the second floor. The fire was knocked down on the first floor allowing for other crews to advance to the second floor and remove the victim from the bedroom. Unfortunately, the second victim was pronounced by the Paramedics on scene. The fire was contained to the structure involved. There were 2 victims transported to the hospital by ambulance.
