Contra Costa County Fire- Engine 85 (Pittsburg), Engine 87(Pittsburg), Truck 84(Pittsburg), Fire Investigator 20(Pittsburg) Training Captain/Safety Officer10 (Concord), 1 Paramedic Unit, 1122(Concord)HQ responded to a reported Medical Aid that turned into a Hazardous Condition. Upon arrival Captain Truck 84 provided care to an elderly male. After the care was completed Captain 84 investigated the smell of Gasoline and found multiple, 5 gallon containers that were being used to store gasoline Illegally. Additional Units were called to assist in mitigating the incident. Upon entry into the unit with the verbal permission of the renter 3 more containers were found and removed. County HazMat was called and provided assistance and removal of the gasoline containers. All units supported these operations commensurate with the strategic objectives. All units were committed for the length of the incident. There were no injuries to Firefighters or civilians.
