All Concerned,

Contra Costa County Firefighters responded to a report of a Commercial Structure Fire early this morning at 802 West 10th Street in Antioch. The fire was reported as burning inside Blue Chip Muffler by Antioch PD. Upon arrival Engine 81

(Antioch) reported heavy black smoke from Blue Chip Muffler. Fire crews opened the front door and started to extinguish the fire. The fire was in the office area and had spread into the garage and attic space. A second alarm was requested. Crew quickly placed hose lines to the interior to extinguish the fire. At the same time crews coordinated cutting holes into the roof for

ventilation. This fire was extinguished because of a well coordinated attack by all firefighters on scene. Searches for civilians were all clear. One unit was damaged by smoke and fire. Our firefighters worked extremely hard and saved 3 other businesses within this building.

No injuries to firefighters or civilians were reported.

Antioch PD assisted with traffic control. PG&E secured the electrical to the entire building.

The fire is still under investigation by our fire investigation unit.
