Just after 5PM yesterday, units were called to a fire in the area of Deer Hill Ln in Antioch. On arrival, we found several vehicles and a home heavily involved in fire. The fire had also begun to spread into the surrounding vegetation. A second alarm was called to assist as well as a full Cal Fire response, bringing additional engines, aircraft and a chief officer. This incident is located in an area that does not have fire hydrants thus making a sustained fire attack on the structures extremely difficult. Due to the heavy fire conditions, crews were limited to evacuating and searching homes to ensure all citizens were safe. Two residents of the homes, sustained smoke inhalation injuries and were transported to a local hospital. This incident is still ongoing as of this morning. We anticipate the day shift to be able to finish the mop up sometime later today. Damage assessment will be ongoing; however, we believe at this time that 4 homes were destroyed, several out buildings and at least 50+ vehicles and equipment were also destroyed. The cause of the fire is under investigation at this time. There were no injuries to incident personnel to date.
