#### *Incident Notification*

**DATE:** October 20, 2018

**TIME OF ALARM:** 1957 hrs.

**TYPE OF ALARM:** Structure Fire

**LOCATION:** 3695 Edmonton Way in Concord

**RESPONSE:** 5 Type 1 Engines, 1 Truck Company, 1 Breathing Support Unit, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator, 1 Shift Training Captain

**ASSISTING AGENCIES:** Con EMS., PG & E, Concord PD, Animal Control

**TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE:** 25

A single alarm working fire was reported at 3695 Edmonton Way in Concord. Upon arrival, Battalion 2 reported a well involved garage fire that was quickly extending into the attic of a single story house. A well coordinated fire attack by Engine 6 on the interior of the house, with Truck 6 providing timely vertical ventilation, and Engine 5 addressing fire attack on the garage, enabled crews to declare knock down on the fire with 20 minutes. All units assigned to the fire were committed to checking for extension in the house, searching for victims, providing water supply, ventilating the house and overhauling the structure to ensure that the fire was completely extinguished.

Early in the incident, it was reported that there could potentially be victims still inside the house. During the initial moments of the fire, a search was initiated and while no victims were found, a dog was discovered in a back bedroom and rescued by interior crews. The dog had labored breathing and was immediately treated by Con EMS personnel. She left the scene on her leash wagging her tail.

The cause of the fire is undetermined at the time of this writing.
