



## Contra Costa County Fire Protection District Battalion 8

### MULTIPLE INCIDENTS

AUGUST 8, 2018

Contra Costa County Fire resources from across the county responded to a number of significant incidents Tuesday and Wednesday this week in the Eastern portion of our Fire District. Below is a briefing on those incidents.

DATE: August 7, 2018

Time of Alarm: 12:38 pm

TYPE OF ALARM: Vegetation Fire

LOCATION: Kirker Pass Road

RESPONSE: 7 Engines, 1 Bull Dozer, 2 Battalion Chiefs - CON, 1 BC CalFire, 1 Safety Officer, 1 Paramedic Ambulance, 1 Paramedic Supervisor, ASSISTING AGENCIES: CHP, Cal FIRE TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 29

All Concerned -

Units from Concord, Pittsburg, Bay Point, Antioch, CHP and Cal Fire responded to a reported Vegetation Fire. Upon arrival E8 reported a car fire with ¼ acre grass, flat slope, slow spread backing to a fire break. E8, E85, E86 and E11 extinguished the fire and completed mop up with the assistance of Cal Fire E1676. Fire was accidental and started from the vehicle fire. Upon arrival Battalion 8 met with Captain 8 and was advised the fire was under control. CHP provided traffic control. All crews remained to complete mop up.

All units were committed for the length of the incident. No firefighters or civilians sustained any injuries.

Time of Alarm: 1:55 pm

TYPE OF ALARM: Vegetation Fire

LOCATION: Hillcrest & Wild Horse Rd. Antioch

RESPONSE: 6 Type 1 Engines, 2 Type III', A Bull Dozer, STC, 2 BC's TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 31

Type I and Type 3 Wildland units from Stations 81, 82, 385, 88, 52, 53, Battalion Chiefs from Pittsburg and Brentwood responded. A structure threat was imminent and resources were instructed to go to the top of the draw and provide structure protection. Crews worked throughout the heat and smoky

conditions to mitigate the incident and provided mop up. All homes were protected. A fire Cause and Origin investigation is ongoing. If you have any further questions please call.
