WHAT: ConFire and local law enforcement will conduct a media-only event designed to share public Independence Day fireworks safety messaging. Attending media will observe a dangers-of-fireworks demonstration, as well as public safety tips and messaging. ConFire and law enforcement officials will be available for comment immediately following the event.
