All concerned,

Contra Costa County Fire Protection District responded to a reported structure fire in a duplex on Mt. Etna Dr. in the City of Clayton. Upon arrival, Engine 11 (Clayton) reported smoke and flames from the backyard. Captain 11 quickly recognized a working fire that was extending throughout the garage and into the attic space of one of the units. After confirming that all residents were safe, crews made an aggressive attack on the fire. The adjoining unit was simultaneously searched and checked for fire extension. Units from Clayton, Concord, Pleasant Hill, and Cal Fire kept the fire from extending into the adjacent unit. The cause and origin of the fire was investigated by the Fire investigator on scene.
