All Concerned---

At 0825 Hrs. E63 (Richmond Fire) and E69 (El Sobrante) responded to the report of a multi-vehicle accident. Upon arrival, Capt. 63 had multiple vehicles involved including a head-on collision with a pick-up truck vs. small school bus. Capt. 63 established command and requested additional resources. BC 7 arrived on scene and took over I.C. and activated a Tier 1 MCI. CHP and The Sheriffs Office blocked the road from both directions for scene safety. All air ambulance request were denied due to the rainy weather and fog. There were a total of 16 patients, 2 with major injuries, 1 with moderate injuries which was the school bus driver who was 35 weeks pregnant, 10 with minor injuries who were transported to area hospitals, and 3 patients who were AMAed (Against Medical Advice). There were 7 children on the school bus with special needs. A West Contra Costa County Unified School District representative arrived on scene to tend to them and assess the school bus.
