On 02/17/18 at 10:50 am, units from Contra Costa County Fire responded to a report of a fire in an apartment building at 2205 Peppertree Way, Antioch. The first fire engine arrived to find the apartment on the second story well involved and an elderly man that appeared to be suffering from smoke inhalation. Fire crews made an aggressive attack on the fire while Contra Costa EMS personnel tended to the patient. The fire was quickly brought under control however there was extensive fire damage in the apartment as well as smoke throughout the building. It was later determined that a neighbor, 30 yr. old Samantha Barnhouse, rescued the 78 yr. old non-ambulatory resident from the burning second story apartment. The resident was transported to the hospital to be evaluated as a precaution. The cause of the fire was determined to be started from an unattended pot left on the stove. Antioch PD assisted with evacuating the residents from the uninvolved units as well as traffic control. Red Cross was summoned to assist the displaced citizens and a \$100.00 SAVE (Supplying Aid to Victims of Emergency) card was issued to the resident to assist with immediate needs from being displaced. There were no reported injuries to firefighters during this incident.
