TIME OF ALARM: 2025 hrs.

TYPE OF ALARM: Structure Fire

LOCATION: 17 Terrace Dr. in Concord

RESPONSE: 5 Type 1 Engines, 1 Truck Company, 1 Breathing Support Unit, 2 Battalion Chiefs, 1 Fire Investigator, 1 Shift Training Captain

ASSISTING AGENCIES: Con EMS., PG & E, Concord PD, Red Cross

TOTAL FIRE PERSONNEL AT SCENE: 25

A single alarm working fire was reported at 17 Terrace Dr. in Concord. Upon arrival, Battalion 2 reported a well involved mobile home fire. A well coordinated fire attack by Engine 6 and Engine 10, enabled crews to declare knock down on the fire within 20 minutes. All units assigned to the fire were committed to checking for extension in the house, searching for victims, providing water supply, ventilating the house and overhauling the structure to ensure that the fire was completely extinguished.

Two adults managed to flee the structure without injuries. In addition, Concord PD evacuated the adjacent mobile homes. Because of a quick fire attack, the back half of the structure was salvaged and many priceless guitars were recovered without damage.

The cause of the fire is undetermined at the time of this writing.
