Locations: 150 Solano Way, Pacheco

Response: 2-Engines, 3-Type 3 engines, 1-Dozer, 1-Water Tender, 1-Investigator, 1-Shift Training Captain, 3-Battalion Chiefs, 2-Assistant Chiefs

Assisting Agencies: MOTCO Fire, Andeavor Refinery Fire Brigade

Total Fire Personnel at Scene: 25

A single alarm vegetation response was reported at 150 Solano Way in Pacheco. Battalion 25 was the first unit on scene and reported approx. 10 acres of grass on fire on the Andeavor Refinery property. Contra Costa Fire personnel assumed command upon arrival at the incident. The fire was wind driven in light fuels, but was boxed in by access roads on the refinery property. Fire crews attacked both flanks of the fire. Type 3 engines were used on the right flank of the fire to ensure that it did not spread to the tank farm on the southwestern edge of the fire. Dozer 220 was assigned to the left flank of the fire. The fire was contained to 73 acres. Andeavor Refinery crews remained on scene overnight to mop up any remaining smoldering material.

The cause of the fire is undetermined at the time of this writing.
