CCCFPD firefighters responded to a reported structure fire. Richmond unit E68 arrived first on scene and reported heavy smoke from 1st and 2nd floor of a two story apartment complex. It was declared a working fire and assignments were given to responding crews. E68 and ConFire units E70 and Squad 70 went into offensive fire attack mode. A permanent water supply was established and a two out crew to protect interior firefighters. The fire was knocked down quickly with no injuries or casualties reported. The complex had eviction notice of all occupants to be out by Sept. 19, 2018. INV20 arrived on scene and a board up company arrived soon after. Fire is under investigation as it seems to have multiple areas of ignition. No person requested temporary shelter yet, Red Cross arrived later and is reported to have assisted 15 people.
